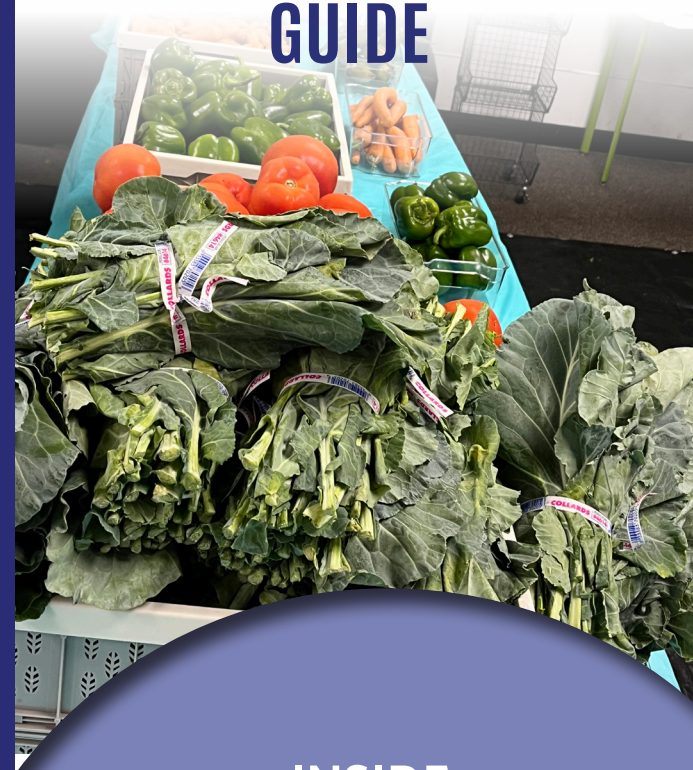

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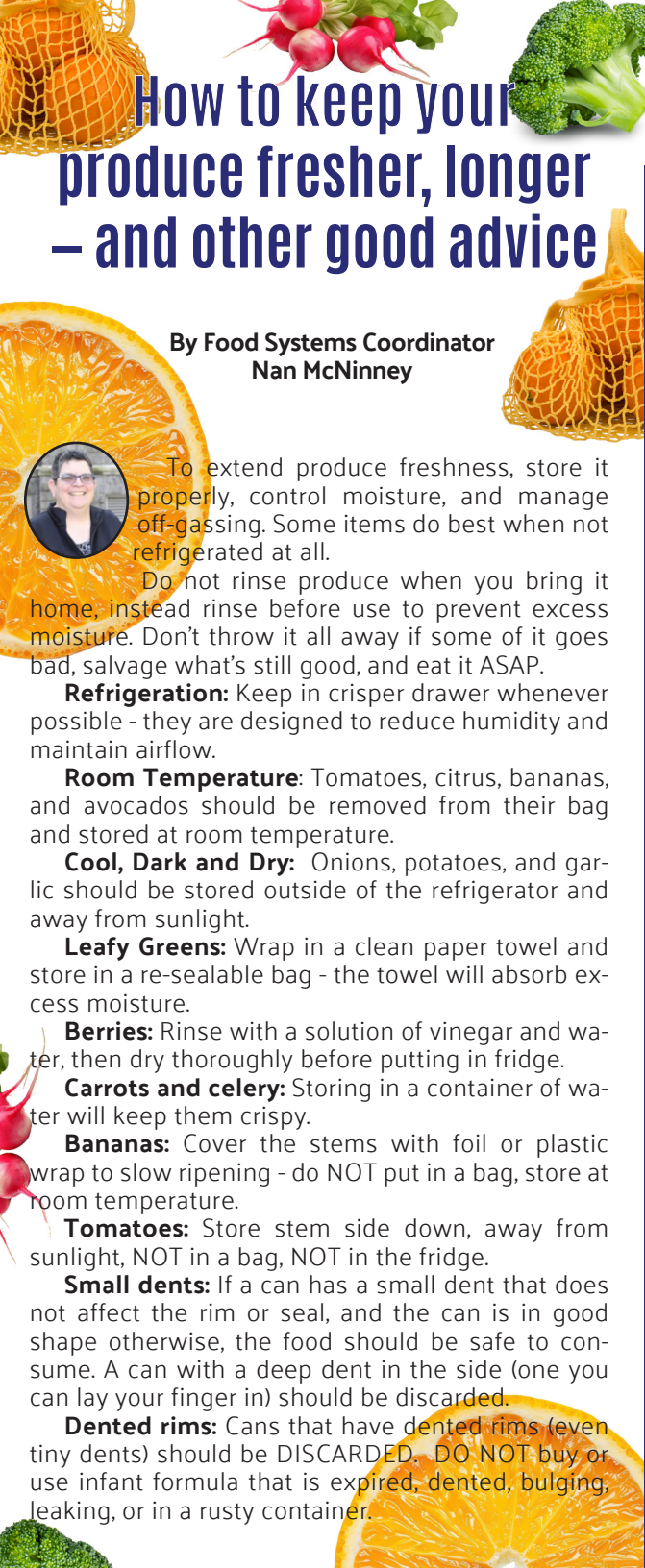

How to keep your produce fresher, longer – and other good advice

To extend produce freshness, store it properly, control moisture, and manage off-gassing. Some items do best when not refrigerated at all.

Do not rinse produce when you bring it home, instead rinse before use to prevent excess moisture. Don't throw it all away if some of it goes bad, salvage what's still good, and eat it ASAP.

Refrigeration: Keep in crisper drawer whenever possible - they are designed to reduce humidity and maintain airflow.

Room Temperature: Tomatoes, citrus, bananas, and avocados should be removed from their bag and stored at room temperature.

Cool, Dark and Dry: Onions, potatoes, and garlic should be stored outside of the refrigerator and away from sunlight.

Leafy Greens: Wrap in a clean paper towel and store in a re-sealable bag - the towel will absorb excess moisture.

Berries: Rinse with a solution of vinegar and water, then dry thoroughly before putting in fridge.

Carrots and celery: Storing in a container of water will keep them crispy.

Bananas: Cover the stems with foil or plastic wrap to slow ripening - do NOT put in a bag, store at room temperature.

Tomatoes: Store stem side down, away from sunlight, NOT in a bag, NOT in the fridge.

Small dents: If a can has a small dent that does not affect the rim or seal, and the can is in good shape otherwise, the food should be safe to consume. A can with a deep dent in the side (one you can lay your finger in) should be discarded.

Dented rims: Cans that have dented rims (even tiny dents) should be DISCARDED. DO NOT buy or use infant formula that is expired, dented, bulging, leaking, or in a rusty container.
