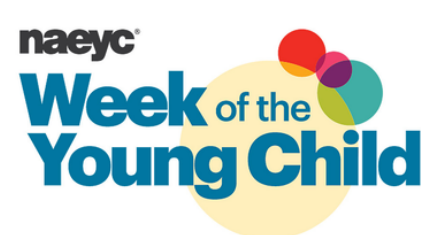
**NO INCOME

Annual backpack and school supply giveaway for Blair County students entering kindergarten through 12<sup>th</sup> grade. Registrations to receive supplies lasts from July through the first week of August! In 2025, 450 students received needed supplies to start off the school year ready to learn.



Annual winter wear giveaway for Blair County children birth through age 5. Children receive a brand-new coat, hat, & gloves to keep them toasty through the colder months. Registration is typically October through early November. In 2025, 710 children received warm winter wear!



The FRC coordinates a Blair County NAEYC Week of the Young Child (WOYC) Celebration each year! This event is typically held in April and celebrates families with young children, early childhood serving programs, and agencies in Blair County. It is a fun filled afternoon with information, activities, and awesome giveaways.
